No. 1193 (Aggravated kidnapping), Penal Code, if the actor committed the 1 offense or engaged in the conduct with intent to violate or abuse 2 3 the victim sexually; a violation of Section 30.02 (Burglary), 4 (D) Penal Code, if the offense or conduct is punishable under 5 Subsection (d) of that section and the actor committed the offense 6 or engaged in the conduct with intent to commit a felony listed in 7 8 Paragraph (A) or (C); violation of Section 9 (E) а 20.02 (Unlawful 10 restraint), 20.03 (Kidnapping), or 20.04 (Aggravated kidnapping), Penal Code, if, as applicable: 11 12 (i) the judgment in the case contains an affirmative finding under Article 42.015; or 13 14 (ii) the order in the hearing or the papers 15 in the case contain an affirmative finding that the victim or intended victim was younger than 17 years of age; 16 17 (F) the second violation of Section 21.08 (Indecent exposure), Penal Code, but not if the second violation 18 19 results in a deferred adjudication; (G) 20 an attempt, conspiracy, or solicitation, as defined by Chapter 15, Penal Code, to commit an offense or engage in 21 conduct listed in Paragraph (A), (B), (C), (D), (E), (K), or (L); 22 a violation of the laws of another state, 23 (H) 24 federal law, the laws of a foreign country, or the Uniform Code of Military Justice for or based on the violation of an offense 25 26 containing elements that are substantially similar to the elements of an offense listed under Paragraph (A), (B), (B-1), (C), (D), (E), 27

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1 (G), (J), (K), [or] (L), or (M), but not if the violation results in a deferred adjudication; 2 the second violation of the laws of another 3 (I) state, federal law, the laws of a foreign country, or the Uniform 4 5 Code of Military Justice for or based on the violation of an offense containing elements that are substantially similar to the elements 6 of the offense of indecent exposure, but not if the second violation 7 8 results in a deferred adjudication; 9 (J) a violation of Section 33.021 (Online solicitation of a minor), Penal Code; 10 (K) a violation of Section 20A.02(a)(3), (4), 11 12 (7), or (8) (Trafficking of persons), Penal Code; [or] (L) a violation of Section 20A.03 (Continuous 13 14 trafficking of persons), Penal Code, if the offense is based partly 15 or wholly on conduct that constitutes an offense under Section 20A.02(a)(3), (4), (7), or (8) of that code; or 16 17 (M) a violation of Section 15.032 (Child grooming), Penal Code. 18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 19 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 20 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 21 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 22

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For

24 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 25 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 26 before that date.

and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
