2 (5) a property, facility, or pipeline described by 3 this section that is under construction and all equipment and 4 appurtenances used during that construction.

5 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 6 7 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 8 9 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 10 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was 11 committed before that date. 12

13 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only 14 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of 15 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date 16 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the cause of 17 action accrued, and the former law is continued in effect for that 18 purpose.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
