- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 424.001, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 424.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "critical
- 9 infrastructure facility" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 10 423.0045(a)(1-a) and also includes:
- 11 (1) any pipeline transporting oil or gas or the
- 12 products or constituents of oil or gas;
- 13 (2) a public or private airport depicted in any
- 14 current aeronautical chart published by the Federal Aviation
- 15 Administration;
- 16 (3) a military installation owned or operated by or
- 17 for the federal government, this state, or another governmental
- 18 entity; [and]
- 19 (4) any property or facility that is:
- 20 (A) used for the launch, landing, or recovery of
- 21 spacecraft, as defined by Section 507.001, Local Government Code;
- 22 and
- 23 (B) licensed by the Federal Aviation
- 24 Administration or operated by a spaceport development corporation

- 1 under Chapter 507, Local Government Code; and
- 2 <u>(5)</u> a <u>property</u>, facility, or pipeline described by
- 3 this section that is under construction and all equipment and
- 4 appurtenances used during that construction.
- 5 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 6 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 7 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 8 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 9 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 10 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 11 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 12 committed before that date.
- 13 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 15 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date
- 16 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the cause of
- 17 action accrued, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 18 purpose.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
