- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 319.005, Labor Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 319.005. REPORT TO LEGISLATURE. Not later than
- 8 December 31 of each even-numbered year[, 2024], the task force
- 9 shall prepare and submit to the legislature a report that includes:
- 10 (1) a description of the activities of the task force;
- 11 (2) the consolidation plan developed by the task
- 12 force; and
- 13 (3) the findings and recommendations of the task
- 14 force.
- SECTION 2. Section 319.006, Labor Code, is amended to read
- 16 as follows:
- 17 Sec. 319.006. EXPIRATION. The task force is abolished and
- 18 this chapter expires September 1, 2027 [2025].
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
