- 26 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 27 disclosure by the Parks and Wildlife Department of information in a

- 1 report described by Section 11.0305(a), Parks and Wildlife Code, as
- 2 added by this Act, that is made on or after the effective date of
- 3 this Act, regardless of when the report containing the information
- 4 was submitted to the department.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
