- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Title 5, Utilities Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Chapter 254 to read as follows:

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- 7 CHAPTER 254. ACCESS BY CERTIFICATED TELECOMMUNICATIONS PROVIDERS
- 8 TO ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE RIGHTS-OF-WAY AND DISTRIBUTION POLES
- 9 Sec. 254.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 10 (1) "Certificated telecommunications provider" means
- 11 <u>a person who has been issued a certificate of convenience and</u>
- 12 <u>necessity</u>, certificate of operating authority, or service provider
- 13 <u>certificate of operating authority by the Public Utility Commission</u>
- 14 of Texas to offer local exchange telephone service or a person who
- 15 provides voice service.
- 16 (2) "Pole" means a pole carrying distribution lines
- 17 with a voltage rating no higher than 34.5 kilovolts.
- 18 (3) "Pole attachment" means an affixture of cables,
- 19 strands, wires, and associated equipment attached to a pole
- 20 directly or indirectly or placed in a right-of-way owned or
- 21 controlled by an electric cooperative.
- 22 <u>Sec. 254.002. NONDISCRIMINATORY ACCESS. (a) An electric</u>
- 23 <u>cooperative</u> shall provide a certificated telecommunications
- 24 provider with nondiscriminatory access regarding:

- 1 (1) the placement of a facility in the electric
- 2 cooperative's right-of-way;
- 3 (2) a pole attachment rate or term for a pole that the
- 4 electric cooperative owns or controls; or
- 5 (3) access to a building relating to Subdivision (1)
- 6 or (2).
- 7 (b) An electric cooperative may not charge a certificated
- 8 telecommunications provider a pole attachment rate that:
- 9 (1) exceeds the rate agreed to in a contract between
- 10 the cooperative and the provider; or
- 11 (2) exceeds the rate that the electric cooperative
- 12 would be permitted to charge under rules adopted by the Federal
- 13 Communications Commission under 47 U.S.C. Section 224(e) if the
- 14 electric cooperative's rates were regulated under federal law and
- 15 the rules of the Federal Communications Commission, which may be
- 16 established by the Public Utility Commission of Texas in a
- 17 contested case proceeding under Chapter 2001, Government Code.
- 18 Sec. 254.003. AUTHORITY OF PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION. (a)
- 19 Notwithstanding Section 41.004, the Public Utility Commission of
- 20 Texas:
- 21 (1) may open a contested case proceeding under Chapter
- 22 2001, Government Code, to determine whether a pole attachment rate
- 23 charged by an electric cooperative to a certificated
- 24 telecommunications provider complies with Section 254.002(b)(2);
- 25 and
- 26 (2) shall enforce this chapter and adopt rules
- 27 <u>reasonably required for that purpose.</u>

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- 1 (b) For the purposes of enforcing this chapter, a reference
- 2 <u>in Chapter 15 to a person includes an electric cooperative.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
