22	(b) The web page described by Subsection (a) must include an		
23	explanation that:		
24	(1) the commission does not and may not provide legal

- 5 SECTION 2. Not later than February 1, 2026, the Texas

- 7 information required by Section 302.0064, Labor Code, as added by

- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
