BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 302, Labor Code, is amended by adding Section 302.0064 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 302.0064. CHILD-CARE RESOURCES FOR EMPLOYERS. (a) The commission shall maintain in a prominent location on its 8 Internet website a link to a web page consisting of comprehensive 9 and current information to help employers assist employees who are 10 parents with accessing child care, including information on: 11 12 (1) child-care assistance; (2) best practices for assisting employees who are 13 14 parents; 15 (3) any available state and federal tax credits; 16 (4) dependent care savings accounts; 17 (5) any available free tools or templates; (6) policies and benefits an employer may adopt to 18 assist employees in accessing child care; and 19 20 (7) other resources related to child care that the commission considers relevant. 21 (b) The web page described by Subsection (a) must include an 22 explanation that: 23 (1) the commission does not and may not provide legal 24

2	(2) an employer is not required to implement any
3	employment policy or benefit included on the web page unless
4	required by other law.
5	SECTION 2. Not later than February 1, 2026, the Texas
6	Workforce Commission shall post on its Internet website the
7	information required by Section 302.0064, Labor Code, as added by
8	this Act.

9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
