- a patient electronically through a patient portal under Subsection 12

- 14 (1) determine whether the patient has created a
- patient profile on the portal; and 15
- 16 (2) if the health care provider determines that the
- patient has not created a patient portal, mail a copy of the 17
- itemized bill to the patient. 18
- SECTION 2. Section 185.003, Health and Safety Code, is 19
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 Sec. 185.003. DISCIPLINARY ACTION ВҮ LICENSING
- AUTHORITY. The appropriate licensing authority 22 shall take
- 23 disciplinary action against <u>a health care</u> [the] provider that
- violates this chapter [for the violation] as if the provider 24

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- 1 violated an applicable licensing law.
- 2 SECTION 3. Section 185.002, Health and Safety Code, as
- 3 amended by this Act, applies only to an itemized bill issued on or
- 4 after the effective date of this Act. An itemized bill issued before
- 5 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on
- 6 the date the itemized bill was issued, and the former law is
- 7 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
