| 8  | Day," in honor of Jefferson Davis, Robert E. Lee, and other          |
| 9  | Confederate heroes;  |
| 10 | [ <del>(2)</del> ] the second day of March, "Texas Independence      |
| 11 | Day";  |
| 12 | (2) [ <del>(3)</del> ] the 21st day of April, "San Jacinto Day";     |
| 13 | (3) [ <del>(4)</del> ] the 19th day of June, "Emancipation Day in    |
| 14 | Texas," in honor of the emancipation of the slaves in Texas in 1865; |
| 15 | (4) the 28th day of June, "Celebration of Suffrage                   |
| 16 | Day," in honor of the centuries-long struggle to bring the right of  |
| 17 | suffrage to all Americans;   |
| 18 | (5) the 27th day of August, "Lyndon Baines Johnson                   |
| 19 | Day," in observance of the birthday of Lyndon Baines Johnson;        |
| 20 | (6) the Friday after Thanksgiving Day;                               |
| 21 | (7) the 24th day of December; and                                    |
| 22 | (8) the 26th day of December.  |
| 23 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.                  |
