5	SECTION 1. Section 26.040, Water Code, is amended by adding
6	Subsections (h-1) and (h-2) to read as follows:
7	(h-1) After the commission denies or suspends a
8	discharger's authority to discharge under a general permit under

- 9 Subsection (h), the discharger may not discharge under the general
- 10 permit until the executive director actively authorizes the
- 11 <u>discharger to use the general permit.</u>
- 12 (h-2) The executive director may not use an automatic
- 13 process to authorize the use of a general permit under Subsection
- 14 (h-1).
- SECTION 2. Sections 26.040(h-1) and (h-2), Water Code, as
- 16 added by this Act, apply only to a denial or suspension ordered on
- 17 or after the effective date of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
