A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the frequency of the notice provided to a retail
3 electric customer by certain electric utilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 17.003(d-1), Utilities Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:

7 (d-1) An electric utility providing electric delivery 8 service for a retail electric provider, as defined by Section 9 31.002, shall provide to the retail electric provider, and the 10 retail electric provider <u>at least quarterly</u> shall [periodically] 11 provide to the retail electric provider's retail customers together 12 with bills sent to the customers, information about:

(1) the electric utility's procedures for implementing involuntary load shedding initiated by the independent organization certified under Section 39.151 for the ERCOT power region;

17 (2) the types of customers who may be considered 18 critical care residential customers, critical load industrial 19 customers, or critical load according to commission rules adopted 20 under Section 38.076;

(3) the procedure for a customer to apply to be considered a critical care residential customer, a critical load industrial customer, or critical load according to commission rules adopted under Section 38.076; and

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S.B. No. 1309 1 (4) reducing electricity use at times when involuntary load shedding events may be implemented. 2 SECTION 2. Section 17.005(f), Utilities Code, is amended to 3 read as follows: 4 5 (f) A municipally owned utility <u>at least quarterly</u> shall [periodically] provide with bills sent to retail customers of the 6 utility information about: 7 8 (1)the utility's procedure for implementing involuntary load shedding; 9 10 (2) the types of customers who may be considered critical care residential customers, critical load industrial 11 12 customers, or critical load according to commission rules adopted under Section 38.076; 13 14 (3) the procedure for a customer to apply to be 15 considered a critical care residential customer, a critical load industrial customer, or critical load according to commission rules 16 17 adopted under Section 38.076; and (4) reducing electricity use at times when involuntary 18 19 load shedding events may be implemented. SECTION 3. Section 17.006(f), Utilities Code, is amended to 20 read as follows: 21 An electric cooperative at least quarterly shall 22 (f) [periodically] provide with bills sent to retail customers of the 23 24 cooperative information about: 25 (1) the cooperative's procedure for implementing 26 involuntary load shedding; 27 (2) the types of customers who may be considered

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1 critical care residential customers, critical load industrial 2 customers, or critical load according to commission rules adopted 3 under Section 38.076;

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4 (3) the procedure for a customer to apply to be 5 considered a critical care residential customer, a critical load 6 industrial customer, or critical load according to commission rules 7 adopted under Section 38.076; and

8 (4) reducing electricity use at times when involuntary9 load shedding events may be implemented.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
