(a) Except as 9 provided by Subsection (c), the commissioners court of a county may 10 adopt an order applicable to unincorporated areas of the county and 11 the governing body of a municipality may adopt an ordinance 12 applicable within the municipality prohibiting the sale of 13 14 cigarettes, e-cigarettes, or tobacco products by an establishment operating within: 15 (1) 300 feet of a church, public hospital, or public or 16 private primary or secondary school campus; 17 18 (2) 1,000 feet of a public primary or secondary school campus on request of the school district board of trustees for the 19 20 campus; or 21 (3) 1,000 feet of a private primary or secondary school campus on request of the governing body of the school. 22 23 (b) The board of trustees of a school district or governing body of a private school may request the commissioners court of a 24

county or governing body of a municipality to adopt a prohibition 1 described by Subsection (a)(2) or (3) for a district or school 2 campus within the described area. 3 (c) A county order or municipal ordinance adopted under this 4 section does not apply to an establishment whose gross receipts 5 6 from the sale of cigarettes, e-cigarettes, and tobacco products is 7 less than 50 percent of the establishment's total gross receipts at the establishment's premises within an area described by Subsection 8 (a)(1), (2), or (3). 9
