- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 161, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 161.0877 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 161.0877. PROHIBITED ENTRY OF MINORS ON PREMISES OF
- 8 SMOKE SHOPS; CRIMINAL OFFENSE. (a) In this section, "smoke shop"
- 9 means an establishment for which the gross receipts from the retail
- 10 sale of cigarettes, e-cigarettes, or tobacco products on the
- 11 establishment's premises is at least 50 percent of the total gross
- 12 receipts from the retail sale of all items on the premises.
- 13 <u>(b) An employee or owner of a smoke shop may not allow a</u>
- 14 minor to enter the premises of the smoke shop unless the minor is
- 15 accompanied by the minor's adult parent or guardian.
- 16 <u>(c) An employee</u> or owner of a smoke shop commits an offense
- 17 if the employee or owner knowingly violates this section. An
- 18 offense under this subsection is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine
- 19 not to exceed \$500.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
