1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to prohibited sales to persons attempting to purchase all  
1-24 or substantially all possible winning tickets in a lottery drawing.  
1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
1-26 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 466, Government Code, is  
1-27 amended by adding Section 466.1555 to read as follows:  
1-28 Sec. 466.1555. PROHIBITED SALES TO PERSONS ATTEMPTING TO  
1-29 PURCHASE ALL OR SUBSTANTIALLY ALL POSSIBLE WINNING LOTTERY TICKETS.  
1-30 (a) A sales agent may not knowingly sell or allow the sale of  
1-31 tickets for a lottery game involving a drawing to one or more  
1-32 persons attempting to purchase all or substantially all possible  
1-33 winning tickets for the drawing.  
1-34 (b) After a hearing, the commission shall revoke a license  
1-35 issued under this chapter to a sales agent who violates Subsection  
1-36 (a) for each of the sales agent's licensed locations.  
1-37 (c) A person whose license is revoked under Subsection (b)  
1-38 may not apply for a sales agent license under this chapter before  
1-39 the first anniversary of the license revocation date.  
1-40 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
