6	Code, is amended by adding Section 102.33 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 102.33. SALE OF LIQUOR BY DISTILLER AND RECTIFIER TO
8	WHOLESALER: CREDIT RESTRICTIONS. (a) The holder of a distiller's
9	and rectifier's permit shall provide a written invoice to the
10	holder of a wholesaler's permit who purchases liquor from the
11	holder of the distiller's and rectifier's permit.
12	(b) The holder of a wholesaler's permit shall pay for liquor
13	purchased from the holder of a distiller's and rectifier's permit in
14	accordance with the agreed terms of a contract or letter of
15	agreement between the holder of the distiller's and rectifier's
16	permit and the wholesaler.
17	(c) If the holder of a wholesaler's permit becomes
18	delinquent in the payment of an invoice for liquor under this
19	section, the holder of the distiller's and rectifier's permit who
20	sold the liquor to the wholesaler may report that fact in writing,
21	along with any supporting documentation, to the commission. For
22	purposes of this section, a wholesaler becomes delinquent in the
23	payment of an invoice if the wholesaler:
24	(1) fails to pay the amount due to the holder of the

No. 1355 distiller's and rectifier's permit on or before the date payment is 1 2 required under the agreed terms of a contract or letter of agreement 3 between the holder of the distiller's and rectifier's permit and the 4 wholesaler; and 5 (2) fails to pay the amount due to the holder of the distiller's and rectifier's permit after receiving a demand for 6 7 payment from the holder of the distiller's and rectifier's permit, in accordance with any agreed payment terms of a contract or letter 8 9 of agreement between the holder of the distiller's and rectifier's permit and the wholesaler. 10 11 (d) It is a violation of this section for the holder of a wholesaler's permit to become delinquent in the payment of an 12 13 invoice under this section. The commission may take disciplinary action against a wholesaler who violates this section. In 14 determining an appropriate disciplinary action for the violation, 15 16 the commission may consider: 17 (1) the duration of the delinquency; 18 (2) the amount of the delinquent payment; (3) any previous violations of this section committed 19 20 by the wholesaler; (4) the financial resources of the wholesaler; and 21 22 (5) any other factors the commission or administrator 23 determines relevant. (e) The commission shall adopt rules to implement this 24 25 section, including rules regarding the submission of supporting documentation by the holder of a distiller's and rectifier's permit 26 27 under Subsection (c).
