10	rule shall require that information relating to construction or

- 14 <u>(1)</u> the dangers associated with violating traffic laws

- 16 (2) the penalties under Section 542.404,
- 17 Transportation Code, for certain offenses committed in a
- 18 construction or maintenance work zone.
- (b) In developing rules under this section, the commission
- 20 <u>shall consult with the Department of Public Safety.</u>
- SECTION 2. (a) Not later than May 1, 2026, the Texas
- 22 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the rules
- 23 required by Section 1001.1102, Education Code, as added by this
- 24 Act.

- 1 (b) Each driver education course or driving safety course
- 2 held on or after September 1, 2026, shall include in the course's
- 3 curriculum the information required by the rules adopted under
- 4 Section 1001.1102, Education Code, as added by this Act.
