1	AN ACT
2	relating to an emergency preparedness and contingency operations
3	plan, including temperature regulation, for nursing facility and
4	assisted living facility residents during an emergency; providing
5	penalties.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 242, Health and Safety
8	Code, is amended by adding Section 242.405 to read as follows:
9	Sec. 242.405. EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND CONTINGENCY
10	OPERATIONS PLAN; TEMPERATURE REGULATION. (a) In this section:
11	(1) "Area of refuge" means a climate-controlled area
12	of a nursing facility that is designated for use during a power
13	outage or other emergency to provide safety, care, and other
14	resources to residents.
15	(2) "Bedfast resident" means a resident who is unable
16	to transfer out of bed and unable to turn and position themselves in
17	bed.
18	(b) A nursing facility shall adopt and implement an
19	emergency preparedness and contingency operations plan that
20	requires the facility to provide in an emergency:
21	(1) for each resident other than a bedfast resident, a

climate-controlled area of refuge with at least 15 square feet per

(2) for each bedfast resident, a climate-controlled

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resident;

- 1 room; and
- 2 (3) notice to the commission of an unplanned
- 3 interruption or loss for more than 12 hours of electric utility
- 4 service.
- 5 (c) An emergency preparedness and contingency operations
- 6 plan adopted in accordance with this section must require a nursing
- 7 <u>facility to maintain a temperature between 68 and 82 degrees</u>
- 8 Fahrenheit for:
- 9 <u>(1) each area of refuge designated for facility</u>
- 10 residents; and
- 11 (2) each climate-controlled room for bedfast
- 12 residents.
- 13 (d) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules to enforce
- 14 this section.
- 15 (e) A nursing facility shall submit the emergency
- 16 preparedness and contingency operations plan required by this
- 17 <u>section to the commission in the form and manner prescribed by the</u>
- 18 commission.
- (f) A nursing facility shall include in the emergency
- 20 preparedness and contingency operations plan adopted in accordance
- 21 with this section its policies and information on:
- 22 (1) building equipment, including the location of and
- 23 type of on-site generator equipment or backup power source; and
- 24 (2) residents, including residents who are bedfast and
- 25 residents who are dependent on electrically powered equipment.
- 26 (g) The commission shall assess a penalty in accordance with
- 27 Subchapter C against a nursing facility found in violation of this

- 2 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 247, Health and Safety
- 3 Code, is amended by adding Section 247.073 to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 247.073. EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND CONTINGENCY
- 5 OPERATIONS PLAN; TEMPERATURE REGULATION. (a) In this section:
- 6 (1) "Area of refuge" means a climate-controlled area
- 7 in an assisted living facility that is designated for use during a
- 8 power outage or other emergency to provide safety, care, and other
- 9 resources to residents.
- 10 (2) "Bedfast resident" means an assisted living
- 11 <u>facility resident who is unable to transfer out of bed and unable to</u>
- 12 turn and position themselves in bed.
- 13 (b) An assisted living facility shall adopt and implement an
- 14 emergency preparedness and contingency operations plan that
- 15 requires the facility to provide in an emergency:
- 16 (1) for each assisted living facility resident other
- 17 than a bedfast resident, a climate-controlled area of refuge with
- 18 at least 15 square feet per resident;
- 19 (2) for each bedfast assisted living facility
- 20 resident, a climate-controlled room; and
- 21 (3) notice to the commission of an unplanned
- 22 interruption or loss for more than 12 hours of electric utility
- 23 <u>service.</u>
- 24 <u>(c) An emergency preparedness and contingency operations</u>
- 25 plan adopted in accordance with this section must require an
- 26 assisted living facility to maintain a temperature between 68 and
- 27 82 degrees Fahrenheit for:

Τ	(1) each area of refuge designated for assisted living
2	facility residents; and
3	(2) each climate-controlled room for bedfast assisted
4	living facility residents.
5	(d) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules to enforce
6	this section.
7	(e) The commission shall establish construction and
8	licensure standards for assisted living facilities constructed
9	after September 1, 2026, including standards for:
10	(1) the integration of backup power systems or a
11	connection point for a backup power system; and
12	(2) the evacuation of assisted living facility
13	residents in emergencies to other buildings on the same premises.
14	(f) An assisted living facility shall submit the emergency
15	preparedness and contingency operations plan required by this
16	section to the commission in the form and manner prescribed by the
17	commission.
18	(g) An assisted living facility shall include in the
19	emergency preparedness and contingency operations plan adopted in
20	accordance with this section its policies and information on:
21	(1) building equipment, including the location of and
22	type of on-site generator equipment or backup power source; and
23	(2) assisted living facility residents, including
24	residents who are bedfast and residents who are dependent on
25	electrically powered equipment.

Subchapter C against an assisted living facility found in violation

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(h) The commission shall assess a penalty in accordance with

1 of this section.

- 2 SECTION 3. (a) Not later than January 1, 2026:
- 3 (1) each nursing facility shall adopt and implement an
- 4 emergency preparedness and contingency operations plan as required
- 5 by Section 242.405, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act;
- 6 and
- 7 (2) each assisted living facility shall adopt and
- 8 implement an emergency preparedness and contingency operations
- 9 plan as required by Section 247.073, Health and Safety Code, as
- 10 added by this Act.
- 11 (b) Notwithstanding Sections 242.405 and 247.073, Health
- 12 and Safety Code, as added by this Act, a nursing facility or
- 13 assisted living facility is not subject to assessment of a penalty
- 14 for a violation of those sections until on or after January 1, 2027.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
