## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the establishment of the office of medical examiner in

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1, Article 49.25, Code of Criminal
- 6 Procedure, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1. OFFICE <u>REQUIRED IN CERTAIN COUNTIES AND AUTHORIZED</u>
- 8 <u>IN OTHER COUNTIES</u>. Subject to the provisions of this article, the
- 9 commissioners court of any county with [having] a population of
- 10 more than one [2.5] million shall establish and maintain the office
- 11 of medical examiner, and the commissioners court of any county with
- 12 <u>a population of less than one million</u> may establish and provide for
- 13 the maintenance of the office of medical examiner. Population
- 14 shall be according to the last preceding federal census.
- SECTION 2. Section 1-a(a), Article 49.25, Code of Criminal
- 16 Procedure, is amended to read as follows:
- 17 (a) The commissioners courts of two or more counties,
- 18 regardless of population size, may enter into an agreement to
- 19 create a medical examiners district and to jointly operate and
- 20 maintain the office of medical examiner of the district. The
- 21 district must include the entire area of all counties
- 22 involved. The counties within the district must, when taken
- 23 together, form a continuous area.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
