BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 411.164, Government Code, is amended to 5 read as follows:

Sec. 411.164. DEFENSE COUNSEL ACCESS TO CRIME LABORATORY 6 PORTAL. 7 In accordance with department rule, the attorney representing the state in a criminal action shall designate [the 8 defendant or] the defendant's attorney[, as appropriate,] as an 9 individual who is authorized to access and use the crime laboratory 10 portal under Section 411.162 to request any crime laboratory 11 12 records that are subject to discovery under Article 39.14, Code of 13 Criminal Procedure.

14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 15 to a criminal proceeding that commences on or after the effective 16 date of this Act. A criminal proceeding that commences before the 17 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the 18 date the proceeding commenced, and the former law is continued in 19 effect for that purpose.
