- 5 SECTION 1. Section 300.0155, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 300.0155. EXPIRATION OF AUTHORITY. (a) Except as
- 8 provided by Subsection (b), the [The] authority of a local
- 9 government to administer and operate a program under this chapter
- 10 expires on September 1 following the second anniversary of the date
- 11 the governing body of the local government adopted the order or
- 12 ordinance authorizing the local government to participate in the
- 13 program as provided by Section 300.0004.
- 14 (b) The authority of a local government to which this
- 15 subsection applies to administer and operate a program under this
- 16 chapter expires on September 1, 2030. This subsection applies only
- 17 to a county:
- 18 (1) with a population of one million or more;
- 19 (2) in which all or part of a municipality with a
- 20 population of one million or more is located; and
- 21 (3) that is located adjacent to a county with a
- 22 population of 2.5 million or more.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
