1-21 relating to the membership of a school district's local school
 1-22 health advisory council.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 28.004, Education Code, is amended by
 1-25 adding Subsections (a-1), (a-2), (a-3), (d-3), (d-4), and (d-5) and
 1-26 amending Subsections (d), (d-1), and (d-2) to read as follows:

1-27 (a-1) Except as provided by Subsection (a-2), each member of
 1-28 the local school health advisory council shall be appointed by an
 1-29 individual trustee of the board of trustees of the school district.
 1-30 Each trustee must appoint an equal number of members to the council.

1-31 (a-2) Notwithstanding Subsection (a-1), the board of
 1-32 trustees of a school district may appoint to a local school health
 1-33 advisory council members described by Subsections (d-2) and (d-3)
 1-34 by a majority vote of the board in lieu of appointing those members
 1-35 by individual trustees.

1-36 (a-3) A member appointed to a local school health advisory
 1-37 council shall serve a one-year term. A member may be reappointed
 1-38 for subsequent one-year terms.

1-39 (d) The board of trustees shall appoint at least five
 1-40 members to the local school health advisory council.

1-41 (d-1) A majority of voting ~~the~~ members must be persons who
 1-42 are parents of students enrolled in the district, ~~and~~ who are not
 1-43 employed by the district, and who do not have a relative within the
 1-44 first degree of consanguinity who is employed by the district. Only
 1-45 a member described by this subsection may ~~One of those members~~
 1-46 ~~shall~~ serve:

1-47 (1) as chair, ~~or~~ co-chair, vice chair, or secretary
 1-48 of the council; or

1-49 (2) in any other executive position for the local
 1-50 school health advisory council.

1-51 (d-2) The board of trustees also may appoint one or more
