A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the procedure for amending or revoking certificates of
3	public convenience and necessity issued to certain water utilities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 13.2541, Water Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsections (b), (b-1), (e), and (f) and adding
7	Subsections (b-2), (b-3), and (e-1) to read as follows:
8	(b) As an alternative to decertification or expedited
9	release under Section 13.254, the owner of a tract of land that is
10	at least 25 acres and that is not receiving water or sewer service
11	may petition for expedited release of the area from a certificate of
12	public convenience and necessity in the manner provided by this
13	section and is entitled to that release.
14	(b-1) This section applies only if the landowner's property
15	is located in:
16	(1) a county with a population of at least 1.2 million;
17	(2) [$_{m{ au}}$] a county adjacent to a county with a population
18	of at least 1.2 million;
19	(3) [τ or] a county with a population of more than
20	200,000 and less than 233,500 that does not contain a public or
21	private university that had a total enrollment in the most recent
22	fall semester of 40,000 or more; or

Subdivision (2) [, and not in a county that has a population of more

(4) a county adjacent to a county described by

- 1 than 50,500 and less than 52,000].
- 2 (b-2) This subsection applies only to a petition for a tract
- 3 of land located in a county described by Subsection (b-1)(4). The
- 4 petitioner shall provide written notice, by certified mail and
- 5 regular mail, to the certificate holder of the petitioner's intent
- 6 to petition the utility commission for expedited release of an area
- 7 from a certificate of public convenience and necessity under this
- 8 section not later than the 60th day before the date on which the
- 9 petitioner submits the petition to the utility commission. The
- 10 notice must include contact information for the property owner
- 11 whose tract or tracts are the subject of the petition. The
- 12 certificate holder may waive the notice required by this
- 13 subsection.
- 14 (b-3) $[\frac{b-1}{a}]$ On the day a petitioner submits a petition to
- 15 the utility commission under this section, the petitioner shall
- 16 send, via certified mail, a copy of the petition to the certificate
- 17 holder, who may submit information to the utility commission to
- 18 controvert information submitted by the petitioner.
- 19 (e) The certificate holder may not initiate an application
- 20 to borrow money under a federal loan program after the date the
- 21 notice is provided or waived under Subsection (b-2) [petition is
- 22 **filed**] until the utility commission issues a decision on the
- 23 petition.
- 24 (e-1) A landowner that submits a petition under this section
- 25 may agree to pay to the certificate holder that is the subject of
- 26 the petition under this section an amount equal to the amount
- 27 necessary to pay or defease a federal loan for a certificate holder

- 1 that is a borrower under a federal loan program. On request from
- 2 the petitioner, the certificate holder must provide the petitioner
- 3 with the amount necessary to pay or defease the federal loan. The
- 4 utility commission may issue an order to require the certificate
- 5 holder to accept a loan payment or defeasance under this section.
- 6 (f) If the utility commission determines that compensation
 7 to the certificate holder is owed under this section and Section
- 8 $\underline{13.254(g)}$, the $[\overline{The}]$ utility commission \underline{shall} $[\overline{may}]$ require an
- 9 award of compensation $\underline{\text{to be paid}}$ by the petitioner to the
- 10 certificate holder [in the manner provided by this section]. If the
- 11 utility commission requires an award of compensation, the utility
- 12 commission shall require the petitioner to submit a report to the
- 13 utility commission verifying for the purposes of Subsection (j)
- 14 that the compensation has been paid to the certificate holder.
- 15 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 16 a proceeding affecting a certificate of public convenience and
- 17 necessity that commences on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 18 A proceeding affecting a certificate of public convenience and
- 19 necessity that commenced before the effective date of this Act is
- 20 governed by the law in effect on the date the proceeding is
- 21 commenced, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
