- 2 relating to establishing the Texas State Seal of Bilingualism and
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 28.028 to read as follows:

Biliteracy for public high school students.

- 7 <u>Sec. 28.028. TEXAS STATE SEAL</u> OF BILINGUALISM AND
- 8 BILITERACY. (a) In this section, "seal" means the Texas State Seal
- 9 of Bilingualism and Biliteracy established under Subsection (b).
- 10 (b) The agency shall establish a seal to recognize high
- 11 school graduates who have attained a high level of proficiency in
- 12 comprehending, speaking, reading, and writing in both English and a
- 13 <u>language other than English.</u>
- 14 (c) The agency, in consultation with appropriate
- 15 stakeholders, shall:
- 16 (1) determine minimum requirements for earning the
- 17 seal, which:

- 18 (A) must be sufficiently rigorous to indicate to
- 19 <u>an employer or postsecondary institution that a student who has</u>
- 20 <u>earned the seal is biliterate;</u>
- 21 (B) may include completion of a project,
- 22 <u>activity</u>, or portfolio; and
- (C) may not condition receipt of the seal on an
- 24 examination created for that purpose; and

- 1 (2) prepare and deliver to each school district an
- 2 insignia that can be affixed or stamped on the diploma of and adopt
- 3 a designation to be included on the transcript of a student who has
- 4 satisfied requirements for earning the seal.
- 5 (d) Each school district shall:
- 6 (1) maintain appropriate records to identify students
- 7 who have earned the seal; and
- 8 (2) for each student who has satisfied requirements
- 9 for earning the seal:
- 10 (A) affix the seal's insignia to the student's
- 11 diploma; and
- 12 (B) include in the student's transcript that the
- 13 student earned the seal.
- 14 (e) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 15 administer this section.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 17 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
