10	the end of the workweek in which the compensatory time was accrued <u>;</u>

12	(2) if not taken during the period described by
13	Subdivision (1), shall be credited to the employee's accumulated
14	vacation leave for purposes of Chapter 661 [or it lapses].
15	SECTION 2. Section 661.152(b), Government Code, is amended
16	to read as follows:
17	(b) The amount of vacation accrues <u>in accordance with this</u>
18	subchapter and Section 659.015(k) and may be taken in accordance
19	with this subchapter.
20	SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply to
21	compensatory time accrued by an employee of the Texas Department of
22	Criminal Justice before, on, or after the effective date of this
23	Act.
24	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
