AN ACT

2 relating to increasing the criminal penalty for the offense of 3 stealing or receiving a stolen check or similar sight order.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 32.24(b), Penal Code, is amended to read 6 as follows:

7 (b) An offense under this section is a <u>state jail felony</u>
8 [Class A misdemeanor].

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 9 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 10 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 11 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense is committed, 12 13 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 14 15 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. 16
