## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to death records maintained by the vital statistics unit of the Department of State Health Services and provided to certain 3 hospitals. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 191, Health and Safety 6 7 Code, is amended by adding Section 191.012 to read as follows: Sec. 191.012. DEATH INFORMATION PROVIDED TO CERTAIN 8 HOSPITALS. (a) The department shall implement an efficient and 9 effective procedure to provide death information to a hospital 10 licensed under Chapter 241 to assist with the hospital's 11 12 participation in the Medicaid managed care program operated under Chapter 540, Government Code. 13 14 (b) The procedure implemented under Subsection (a) at a minimum must provide the following information for each deceased 15 16 person for whom a death certificate is filed with a local registrar in this state: 17 18 (1) the county of residence of the deceased; (2) the date of birth of the deceased; and 19 (3) the full name of the deceased. 20 21 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act a state agency determines a waiver or authorization from a federal 22 23 agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, the

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agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or

- authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
  waiver or authorization is granted.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
