## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a study on the feasibility of this state conducting a
- 3 census of the residents of this state.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. STUDY ON FEASIBILITY OF STATE CENSUS. (a) The
- 6 state demographer under Chapter 468, Government Code, shall conduct
- 7 a study to assess the feasibility of this state conducting a census
- 8 to more accurately determine the population of the residents of
- 9 this state. The study must:
- 10 (1) consider the costs, benefits, and challenges of
- 11 this state conducting a census; and
- 12 (2) identify policy areas where access to more
- 13 detailed demographic information may reduce state spending,
- 14 including spending through appropriations.
- 15 (b) In conducting the study under this section, the state
- 16 demographer shall assume that the state census being studied will
- 17 include a census question asking each resident of this state
- 18 whether the resident is a United States citizen.
- 19 SECTION 2. REPORT. Not later than July 1, 2026, the state
- 20 demographer shall prepare and submit to the legislature a report on
- 21 the results of the study conducted under Section 1 of this Act.
- 22 SECTION 3. EXPIRATION. This Act expires September 1, 2026.
- 23 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September
- 24 1, 2025.
