1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to requiring the Department of Public Safety to share data  
1-22 for the purpose of maintaining the statewide voter registration  
1-23 list.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 18, Election Code, is  
1-26 amended by adding Section 18.0625 to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 18.0625. USE OF DRIVER'S LICENSE DATA. (a) To  
1-28 maintain the statewide voter registration list and to prevent  
1-29 duplication of registration in more than one state or jurisdiction,  
1-30 the secretary of state shall use data of registered voters who apply  
1-31 for a driver's license or personal identification card in another  
1-32 state to identify voters:

1-33 (1) whose addresses have changed;

1-34 (2) who are not qualified under Section 11.002(a)(4);

1-35 or

1-36 (3) who are registered to vote in more than one state.

1-37 (b) For purposes of implementing this section, the  
1-38 Department of Public Safety shall share with the secretary of state  
1-39 any data related to individuals who hold a driver's license or  
1-40 personal identification card in this state and who apply for a  
1-41 driver's license or personal identification card in another state.

1-42 (c) The secretary of state may, in consultation with the  
1-43 Department of Public Safety, adopt rules and establish procedures  
1-44 for the administration of this section.

1-45 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
