- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 11.201, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (b-1) A school district may not employ a superintendent for
- 9 <u>an annual salary in an amount that is greater than twice the amount</u>
- 10 of the highest annual salary paid to a classroom teacher in the
- 11 district.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 12.136, Education Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 12.136. [POSTING OF] CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER SALARY.
- 15 An open-enrollment charter school:
- (1) may not employ a superintendent or, as applicable,
- 17 <u>an administrator serving as educational leader and chief executive</u>
- 18 officer for an annual salary in an amount that is greater than twice
- 19 the amount of the highest annual salary paid to a classroom teacher
- 20 at the school; and
- 21 (2) shall post on the school's Internet website the
- 22 salary of the school's superintendent or, as applicable, of the
- 23 administrator serving as educational leader and chief executive
- 24 officer.

- 1 SECTION 3. This Act applies to an employment contract that
- 2 is entered into on or after September 1, 2025. An employment
- 3 contract that is entered into before September 1, 2025, is governed
- 4 by the law as it existed at the time the contract was entered into,
- 5 and the former law remains in effect for that purpose.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
