BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 41.0052(a), Election Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

7 (a) The governing body of a political subdivision, other 8 than a county or municipal utility district, that holds its general 9 election for officers on a date other than the November uniform 10 election date may, not later than December 31, <u>2025</u> [2016], change 11 the date on which it holds its general election for officers to the 12 November uniform election date <u>in odd-numbered years</u>.

13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
