4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter B, Chapter 2311,
- Occupations Code, as added by Chapter 1153 (S.B. 1001), Acts of the
- 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023, is amended to read as 7
- follows: 8

- SUBCHAPTER B. COMMISSION AND DEPARTMENT POWERS AND DUTIES 9
- SECTION 2. Chapter 2311, Occupations Code, as added by 10
- Chapter 1153 (S.B. 1001), Acts of the 88th Legislature, Regular 11
- 12 Session, 2023, is amended by adding Subchapter B-1 to read as
- 13 follows:
- 14 SUBCHAPTER B-1. ELECTRIC VEHICLE SUPPLY EQUIPMENT ADVISORY BOARD
- Sec. 2311.0251. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter: 15
- 16 (1) "Advisory board" means the Electric Vehicle Supply
- Equipment Advisory Board. 17
- 18 (2) "Executive director" means the executive director
- of the department. 19
- Sec. 2311.0252. ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERSHIP. (a) 20
- 21 advisory board consists of nine voting members appointed by the
- presiding officer of the commission, with the commission's 22
- 23 approval, as follows:
- 24 (1) three members who represent electric vehicle

- 1 supply equipment companies;
- 2 (2) two members who install or service electric
- 3 vehicle supply equipment;
- 4 (3) two members who represent the motor fuel retail
- 5 industry;
- 6 (4) one member who represents a public utility
- 7 company; and
- 8 (5) one member of the public.
- 9 (b) The presiding officer of the commission, with the
- 10 approval of the commission, shall appoint two ex officio nonvoting
- 11 members of the board. An ex officio member is not counted as a
- 12 member for purposes of establishing a quorum. Members appointed
- 13 under this subsection must include:
- 14 (1) one member who represents the Texas Department of
- 15 Transportation; and
- 16 (2) one member who represents the Texas Commission on
- 17 Fire Protection.
- 18 (c) Appointments to the advisory board shall be made without
- 19 regard to the race, color, disability, sex, religion, age, or
- 20 national origin of the appointees.
- Sec. 2311.0253. TERMS; VACANCIES. (a) Advisory board
- 22 members serve six-year terms.
- (b) If a vacancy occurs during a member's term, the
- 24 presiding officer of the commission, with the commission's
- 25 approval, shall appoint a replacement to fill the unexpired term.
- Sec. 2311.0254. PRESIDING OFFICER. The presiding officer
- 27 of the commission, with the commission's approval, shall appoint

- 1 one advisory board member to serve as presiding officer of the board
- 2 for a term of two years.
- 3 Sec. 2311.0255. ADVISORY BOARD DUTIES. The advisory board
- 4 may advise the commission and department on:
- 5 (1) the adoption of appropriate standards for the
- 6 installation, maintenance, calibration, alteration, operation,
- 7 testing, or inspection, as applicable, of electric vehicle supply
- 8 equipment; and
- 9 (2) other issues affecting electric vehicle charging
- 10 stations.
- Sec. 2311.0256. MEETINGS; QUORUM. (a) The advisory board
- 12 shall meet at the call of the executive director or the presiding
- 13 officer of the commission.
- (b) A majority of the voting members of the advisory board
- 15 constitutes a quorum.
- Sec. 2311.0257. EXPIRATION. The advisory board is
- 17 abolished and this subchapter expires December 1, 2030.
- SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2025, the presiding
- 19 officer of the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall
- 20 appoint members to the Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment Advisory
- 21 Board in accordance with Section 2311.0252, Occupations Code, as
- 22 added by this Act.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
