## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the frequency with which the Board of Pardons and
3	Paroles reconsiders inmates for release on parole.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections $508.141(g)$ and $(g-1)$ , Government Code,
6	are amended to read as follows:
7	(g) The board shall adopt a policy establishing the date on
8	which the board may reconsider for release an inmate who has
9	previously been denied release. The policy must require the board
10	to reconsider the inmate for release[+
11	[ <del>(1) an inmate serving a sentence for an offense</del>
12	listed in Section 508.149(a) or for an offense punishable as a
13	felony of the second or third degree under Section 22.04, Penal
14	Code, during a month designated under Subsection (g-1) by the
15	parole panel that denied release[; and
16	[ <del>(2) an inmate other than an inmate described by</del>
17	Subdivision (1) as soon as practicable after the first anniversary
18	of the date of the denial].
19	(g-1) The month designated <u>for reconsideration</u> [ <del>under</del>
20	Subsection (g)(1) by the parole panel that denied release] must:
21	(1) except as provided by Subdivision (2), begin after
22	the first anniversary of the date of the denial and end before the

- 1 an offense under Section 22.021, Penal Code, or a life sentence for
- 2 a capital felony, [in which event the designated month must] begin
- 3 after the first anniversary of the date of the denial and end before
- 4 the 10th anniversary of the date of the denial.
- 5 SECTION 2. (a) Section 508.141, Government Code, as
- 6 amended by this Act, applies to any inmate who is confined in a
- 7 facility operated by or under contract with the Texas Department of
- 8 Criminal Justice on or after the effective date of this Act,
- 9 regardless of whether the offense for which the inmate is confined
- 10 occurred before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- 11 (b) The Board of Pardons and Paroles shall adopt a policy
- 12 consistent with Section 508.141, Government Code, as amended by
- 13 this Act, as soon as practicable after the effective date of this
- 14 Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
