- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 35, Utilities Code, is 6
- 7 amended by adding Section 35.154 to read as follows:
- Sec. 35.154. LOCATION PERMIT. (a) In this section, 8
- 9 "person" includes an electric cooperative and a municipally owned
- 10 utility.

- 11 (b) A person may not install electric energy storage
- 12 equipment or facilities intended for use in selling energy or
- ancillary services at wholesale in the ERCOT power region unless 13
- 14 the person holds a permit issued under this section.
- (c) The commission by rule shall require each permitted 15
- 16 electric energy storage equipment or facility to be installed only
- in a location that: 17
- 18 (1) is a sufficient distance from any other electric
- energy storage equipment or facility to reasonably mitigate the 19
- risk of a fire at the permitted electric energy storage equipment or 20
- facility spreading to other electric energy storage equipment or 21
- 22 facilities; and
- 23 (2) in the event of a fire at the site of the permitted
- 24 electric energy storage equipment or facility, is reasonably

- 1 unlikely to block the only access point to a residential area.
- 2 (d) A person may apply for a permit under this section by
- 3 filing with the commission:
- 4 (1) a description of the proposed location of the
- 5 electric energy storage equipment or facilities;
- 6 (2) a description of the type of electric energy
- 7 storage equipment or facilities;
- 8 (3) a statement identifying the fire department, as
- 9 defined by Section 419.021, Government Code, volunteer fire
- 10 department, fire marshal, or other first responder entity that may
- 11 reasonably be expected to be the primary first responder to a fire
- 12 at the location of the electric energy storage equipment or
- 13 facilities;
- 14 (4) a statement that the person has provided written
- 15 notice to the entity identified in Subdivision (3) of the
- 16 applicant's intent to install electric energy storage equipment or
- 17 facilities; and
- 18 (5) any other information required by commission rule.
- 19 (e) When an application for a permit, or an amendment to a
- 20 permit issued under this section, is filed, the commission shall
- 21 give notice of the application to the county judge of the county in
- 22 which all or a majority of the electric energy storage equipment or
- 23 <u>facilities are proposed to be located.</u>
- 24 (f) The commission may hold one or more public meetings on a
- 25 permit application in the county in which the electric energy
- 26 storage equipment or facilities are proposed to be located. The
- 27 commission shall hold a public meeting:

- 1 (1) on the request of a member of the legislature who
- 2 represents the area in which the electric energy storage equipment
- 3 or facilities are proposed to be located; or
- 4 (2) if the commission determines there is substantial
- 5 public interest in the proposed permit.
- 6 (g) The commission by order or rule may delegate to the
- 7 <u>executive director or another commission employee the authority to</u>
- 8 hold a public meeting under this section.
- 9 (h) The commission may approve an application for a permit
- 10 only if the commission finds that:
- 11 (1) issuance of the permit would not violate state or
- 12 federal law; and
- 13 (2) the location of the proposed electric energy
- 14 storage equipment or facilities complies with rules adopted under
- 15 Subsection (c).
- 16 <u>(i) The commission by rule shall adopt a fee to be imposed on</u>
- 17 each permit applicant to cover costs associated with implementing
- 18 this section.
- 19 (j) For purposes of this section:
- 20 (1) a provision of Subchapter B or E, Chapter 14, that
- 21 <u>authorizes the commission to regulate a public utility also applies</u>
- 22 to a person required to obtain a permit under this section,
- 23 including an electric cooperative or a municipally owned utility;
- 24 and
- 25 (2) a reference in Chapter 15 to a person includes a
- 26 person required to obtain a permit under this section, including an
- 27 electric cooperative or a municipally owned utility.

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- 1 SECTION 2. Section 35.154, Utilities Code, as added by this
- 2 Act, applies only to electric energy storage equipment or
- 3 facilities interconnected to a transmission facility on or after
- 4 the effective date of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
