- 6 SECTION 1. Section 42.042, Human Resources Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Subsections (e-6), (e-7), (e-8), and (e-9) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (e-6) The commission, the department, and a child-placing
- 10 agency that contracts with the department may not require an agency
- 11 foster home to:
- 12 (1) disclose the specific types of firearms that are
- 13 present in the home; or
- 14 (2) notify the child-placing agency if there is any
- 15 change in the types of firearms that are present in the home.
- 16 (e-7) If the commission, the department, or a child-placing
- 17 agency that contracts with the department has or obtains
- 18 information relating to the types of firearms that are present in an
- 19 agency foster home, the commission, department, or child-placing
- 20 agency may not use that information for any purpose other than
- 21 determining whether there are firearms present in the home.
- 22 (e-8) A child-placing agency that violates Subsection (e-7)
- 23 is liable to the state for a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed
- 24 \$5,000 for each violation. The attorney general may bring an action

- 1 to recover a civil penalty authorized under this subsection.
- 2 <u>(e-9)</u> Information relating to the types of firearms that are
- 3 present in an agency foster home is confidential and is not subject
- 4 to disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
