(b) The commission, in collaboration with the agency and 18 coordinating board and in consultation with representatives 19 designated by the Public Utility Commission of Texas to coordinate 20 this state's nuclear energy strategies, by rule shall establish and 21 22 administer the advanced nuclear energy workforce development

program under this section for the purpose of addressing urgent

skilled labor demands in the advanced nuclear energy industry in

2	(c) Under the program, the commission shall:
3	(1) create a strategic plan for:
4	(A) addressing labor supply gaps and talent
5	retention issues in the advanced nuclear energy industry; and
6	(B) providing financial assistance, including
7	through the creation of strategic partnerships among public and
8	private entities and advanced nuclear energy industry
9	stakeholders, to incentivize and support:
10	(i) the development of programming and
11	outreach efforts designed to create awareness of nuclear science
12	and career opportunities in the field of advanced nuclear energy
13	among public school students;
14	(ii) the creation of academic pathways from
15	secondary school to education and training programs at institutions
16	of higher education in the field of advanced nuclear energy;
17	(iii) the creation by institutions of
18	higher education of education and training programs in the field of
19	advanced nuclear energy; and
20	(iv) research and leadership development in
21	the field of advanced nuclear energy at general academic teaching
22	institutions; and
23	(2) develop customized curriculum requirements for
24	degree and certificate programs to prepare students for high-wage
25	jobs in the advanced nuclear energy industry that, subject to
26	coordinating board approval under Section 61.0512, Education Code,
27	may be offered by an institution of higher education.

1	(d) In developing curriculum requirements under Subsection
2	(c)(2), the commission shall:
3	(1) consult with:
4	(A) representatives of the agency, coordinating
5	board, general academic teaching institutions, public technical
6	institutes, and public junior colleges;
7	(B) the designated representatives of the Public
8	Utility Commission of Texas described by Subsection (b); and
9	(C) employers in the advanced nuclear energy
10	industry; and
11	(2) focus on developing academic pathways to and
12	curricula for programs leading to high-wage jobs in the areas of:
13	(A) nuclear-grade welding;
14	(B) radiological control and monitoring;
15	(C) reactor operations;
16	(D) nuclear instrumentation and control; and
17	(E) nuclear, electrical, chemical, civil, and
18	environmental engineering.
19	(e) Not later than September 1 of each year, the commission,
20	in consultation with the agency and coordinating board, shall
21	prepare and submit to each standing committee of the legislature
22	with primary jurisdiction over workforce development, higher
23	education, or energy industry matters, a report summarizing the
24	commission's activities under the program. The report may include
25	the commission's recommendations for legislative or other action.
26	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
