- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.0023(e), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (e) Cardiopulmonary resuscitation instruction must include
- 8 training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation techniques and training
- 9 in the use of an automated external defibrillator and must
- 10 incorporate psychomotor skills to support the instruction. The
- 11 instruction must be [that has been] developed:
- 12 (1) by the American Heart Association or the American
- 13 Red Cross; or
- 14 (2) using nationally recognized, evidence-based
- 15 guidelines for emergency cardiovascular care [and incorporating
- 16 psychomotor skills to support the instruction].
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 18 school year.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
