16	(A) apply for unemployment compensation benefits
17	under Subtitle A and unemployment compensation benefits that may be
18	offered under a program administered by an agency of the federal

20	(B) contact the Texas Veterans Commission,
21	including how an employee may access the Internet website
22	maintained by the Texas Veterans Commission and the veterans crisis
23	hotline established by the United States Department of Veterans

1	(C) exercise any tax benefits or preferences
2	offered to veterans under the Tax Code or Internal Revenue Code of
3	1986; and
4	(D) obtain a driver's license or personal
5	identification card issued by the Department of Public Safety; and
6	(2) services that may be available to veterans in this

8	(A) education, workforce placement, and training
9	programs;

21	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
