11	center of excellence recognition to a justice or judge, the council
12	<pre>must consider:</pre>
13	(1) a justice's or judge's governance, access,
14	fairness, case flow management, and court operations; and
15	(2) the compliance of the justice's or judge's court
16	with statutory or procedural requirements for judicial reporting,
17	court security, fee collection, indigent defense, and guardianship
18	fraud and abuse prevention.
19	(b) A justice or judge of an appellate court, district
20	court, statutory county court, county court, justice court, or
21	municipal court is eligible for recognition as a center of
22	excellence and may apply for recognition on a form and in the manner
23	prescribed by the council.
24	SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
