14	(1) a justice's or judge's governance, access,

16	(2) the compliance of the justice's or judge's court
17	with statutory or procedural requirements for judicial reporting,
18	court security, fee collection, indigent defense, and guardianship
19	fraud and abuse prevention.
20	(b) A justice or judge of an appellate court, district
21	court, statutory county court, or county court is eligible for
22	recognition as a center of excellence and may apply for recognition
23	on a form and in the manner prescribed by the council.
24	(c) In addition to the annual salary paid to a justice or

1	judge under Section 659.012 or by the commissioners court of a
2	county under any other law, a justice or judge recognized as a
3	center of excellence under the centers of excellence program is
4	entitled to receive in each state fiscal year in which the justice
5	or judge is recognized one merit payment in an amount equal to five
6	percent of the justice's or judge's annual base salary for that
7	year.
8	SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
9	a justice or judge recognized under a centers of excellence program

10 developed by the Texas Judicial Council on or after the effective 11 date of this Act.
