A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to fees assessed by the Lost Pines Groundwater 3 Conservation District. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 8849.151, Special District Local Laws 5 Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 8849.151. [PUMPING] FEES. (a) The district may 7 assess production [regulatory pumping] fees under Section 8 36.205(c), Water Code, and export fees under Section 36.122, Water 9 Code [for water produced in or exported from the district]. 10 11 The production [regulatory pumping] fees the district (b) 12 assesses for water for crop or livestock production or other agricultural uses may not exceed 20 percent of the rate applied to 13 14 water for municipal uses. (c) <u>Production</u> [Regulatory pumping] fees [based on the 15 amount of water withdrawn from a well] may not exceed: 16 (1) \$1 for each acre-foot for water used to irrigate 17 agricultural crops; or 18 (2) 17 cents for each thousand gallons for water used 19 20 for any other purpose. 21 [(d) Combined regulatory pumping fees for production and 22 export of water may not exceed 17 cents for each thousand gallons 23 for water used. 24 SECTION 2. Mitigation payments and fees assessed before the

S.B. No. 1611 1 effective date of this Act are ratified, confirmed, and validated 2 in all respects.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
