## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to the purposes for which the Texas Water Bank and the 3 Texas Water Trust may accept and hold water rights. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 12.028(b), Parks and Wildlife Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: (b) Consistent with Section 11.0235(b), Water Code, and the 7 department's duties and responsibilities, the department shall 8 encourage and facilitate the dedication of water rights in the 9 Texas Water Trust through lease, donation, purchase, or other means 10 11 of voluntary transfer for conservation or environmental needs, 12 including for the purpose of maintaining or improving: 13 (1) water supply management; 14 (2) instream flows; (3)  $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$  water quality; 15 (4)  $[\frac{(3)}{(3)}]$  fish and wildlife habitat; and 16

18 SECTION 2. Section 15.703(a), Water Code, is amended to

(5) [(4)] bay and estuary inflows.

- read as follows: 19
- 20 The board may take all actions necessary to operate the 21 water bank and to facilitate the transfer of water rights from the 22 water bank for future beneficial use including but not limited to:
- (1) negotiating a sale price and terms acceptable to 23 24 the depositor and purchaser;

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- 1 (2) maintaining a registry of water bank deposits and
- 2 those water users in need of additional supplies;
- 3 (3) informing water users in need of additional supply
- 4 of water rights available in the bank;
- 5 (4) encouraging water right holders to implement water
- 6 conservation practices and deposit the right to use the conserved
- 7 water into the bank;
- 8 (5) establishing requirements for deposit of a water
- 9 right into the water bank including minimum terms for deposit;
- 10 (6) purchasing, holding, and transferring water or
- 11 water rights in its own name;
- 12 (7) establishing regional water banks;
- 13 (8) acting as a clearinghouse for water marketing
- 14 information including water availability, pricing of water
- 15 transactions, environmental considerations, and potential buyers
- 16 and sellers of water rights;
- 17 (9) preparing and publishing a manual on structuring
- 18 water transactions;
- 19 (10) accepting and holding donations of water rights
- 20 to meet conservation or environmental needs, including water supply
- 21 <u>management</u>, instream <u>flow</u>, water quality, fish and wildlife
- 22 habitat, or bay and estuary inflow needs;
- 23 (11) entering into contracts with persons to pay for
- 24 feasibility studies or the preparation of plans and specifications
- 25 relating to water conservation efforts or to estimate the amount of
- 26 water that would be saved through conservation efforts; and
- 27 (12) other actions to facilitate water transactions.

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- 1 SECTION 3. Section 15.7031(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 2 read as follows:
- 3 (a) The Texas Water Trust is established within the water
- 4 bank to hold water rights dedicated to conservation or
- 5 environmental needs, including <u>water supply management</u>, instream
- 6 flow [flows], water quality, fish and wildlife habitat, or bay and
- 7 estuary <u>inflow needs</u> [<u>inflows</u>].
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
