S.B. No. 1694

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

# 1 AN ACT

2 relating to the source of power for stations and other equipment  
3 used to dispense energy to electric vehicles.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Chapter [2311](#), Occupations Code, as added by  
6 Chapter 211 (S.B. 1732), Acts of the 88th Legislature, Regular  
7 Session, 2023, is redesignated as Chapter 2311A, Occupations Code,  
8 and amended to read as follows:

9 CHAPTER 2311A [2311]. ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS

10 Sec. 2311A.001 [~~2311.001~~]. ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING  
11 STATION STANDARDS. (a) This section applies only to an electric  
12 vehicle charging station that is:

18 (b) The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation, in  
19 consultation with the Texas Department of Transportation, shall  
20 adopt standards for electric vehicle charging stations that require  
21 the charging stations to be:

(2) powered only by renewable energy sources.

2 SECTION 2. Section 2311.0301, Occupations Code, is amended  
3 to read as follows:

4 Sec. 2311.0301. DUTIES OF ELECTRIC VEHICLE SUPPLY PROVIDER.

5 Unless electric vehicle supply equipment is exempt from the  
6 application of this chapter or has been removed from service, an  
7 electric vehicle supply provider shall:

10 (2) maintain electric vehicle supply equipment in  
11 compliance with maintenance specifications, this chapter, and  
12 commission rule; and

15 SECTION 3. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails  
16 over another Act of the 89th Legislature, Regular Session, 2025,  
17 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted  
18 codes.

19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
23 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
