          SECTION 2. Chapter 26, Education Code, is amended by adding
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    Section 26.017 to read as follows:
          Sec. 26.017. NOTICE REGARDING SCHOOL LIBRARY MATERIALS.
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   (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a school district shall
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notify a parent of each child enrolled in the district by e-mail

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- 1 each time the parent's child obtains a school library material from
- 2 a school library in the district. The notice must include the title
- 3 and author of the school library material.
- 4 (b) Before each school year, a school district shall provide
- 5 written notice to a parent of each child enrolled in the district
- 6 regarding the option to submit a written or electronic request to
- 7 opt out of the notifications required under Subsection (a).
- 8 (c) A school district shall:
- 9 (1) maintain a current list of parents to be notified
- 10 under Subsection (a); and
- 11 (2) promptly process opt-out requests under
- 12 Subsection (b).
- SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 14 school year.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
