13	SECTION 2. Section 232.022, Local Government Code, is
14	amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to
15	read as follows:
16	(b) This subchapter applies only to land that is subdivided
17	into two or more lots that are intended primarily for residential

- into two or more lots that are intended primarily for residential use in the jurisdiction of the county. A lot is presumed to be intended for residential use if the lot is five acres or less.
- 20 <u>(b-1)</u> This subchapter does not apply if the subdivision is 21 incident to the conveyance of the land as a gift between persons 22 related to each other within the third degree by affinity or 23 consanguinity, as determined under Chapter 573, Government Code.
- 24 This subchapter applies to a subsequent conveyance of any lot that

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- 1 is not a conveyance to a related person described by this
- 2 <u>subsection</u>.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
