5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 55.004, Occupations Code, is amended by
7	adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
8	(b-1) On receipt by a state agency of an application for a
9	license in accordance with this section, the agency shall promptly
10	issue a provisional license to the applicant while the agency
11	processes the application or issue the license for which the
12	applicant applied. A provisional license issued under this
13	subsection expires on the earlier of:
14	(1) the date the agency approves or denies the
15	provisional license holder's application for the license; or
16	(2) the 180th day after the date the provisional
17	license is issued.
18	SECTION 2. Section 55.0041, Occupations Code, is amended by
19	adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
20	(b-1) On receipt by a state agency of the notice and
21	information required by Subsections (b)(1) and (2), the agency
22	shall promptly issue the confirmation under Subsection (b)(3) or
23	issue a provisional license to the military service member or
24	military spouse pending the issuance of a confirmation under

1	Subsection (b)(3). A provisional license issued under this
2	subsection expires on the earlier of:
3	(1) the date the agency issues or denies confirmation
4	under Subsection (b)(3); or
5	(2) the 180th day after the date the provisional
6	license is issued.
7	SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2025, a state agency,
8	as defined by Section 55.001, Occupations Code, shall adopt rules
9	to implement Sections 55.004(b-1) and 55.0041(b-1), Occupations
10	Code, as added by this Act.

11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
