- 10 Sec. 34.013. INAPPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. This chapter
- 11 does not apply to disclosure of records pertaining to [voluntary
- 12 or therapeutic termination of pregnancy, and those records may not
- 13 be collected, maintained, or disclosed under this chapter.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
