6	SECTION 1. Section $54.213$ , Education Code, is amended by
7	adding Subsections (a-1) and (c) and amending Subsection (b) to

9	(a-1) This section applies only to a nonresident student

11	(1) is a United States citizen or lawful permanent
12	resident of the United States;
13	(2) holds a valid United States nonimmigrant visa
14	issued by the federal government; or
15	(3) is otherwise lawfully present in the United

17	(b) The total number of students at an institution paying
18	resident tuition under this section for a particular semester may

(1) five percent of the total number of students

- 3 Coordinating Board rule:
- 4 (A) the institution is located in a local
- 5 workforce development area that is experiencing a population growth
- 6 rate less than the statewide average according to the most recent
- 7 federal decennial census; and
- 8 (B) the most recent space usage efficiency report
- 9 prepared by the coordinating board indicates the institution has
- 10 sufficient capacity to support the nonresident students.
- 11 (c) The coordinating board shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 12 <u>implement this section</u>.
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 14 54.213, Education Code, applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 15 academic year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
