SECTION 2. Section 13.072, Election Code, is amended by 18 19 adding Subsections (e), (f), and (g) to read as follows: (e) If a voter registration application indicates the 20 applicant's previous residence was outside of this state, the voter 21 registrar shall document the applicant's full legal name, date of 22 birth, current address of residence, and previous address of 23 residence. 24 (f) The voter registrar shall compile the data described by 25 26 Subsection (e) and, at least once a month, submit the data to the secretary of state. The transmitted data must include the 27
