S.B. No. 1874

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to immunity from certain disciplinary proceedings against
3 a professional employee of a school district for certain actions
4 concerning public school discipline and law and order.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 22, Education Code, is
7 amended by adding Section 22.05121 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 22.05121. IMMUNITY FROM DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS FOR
9 ACTIONS RELATED TO DISCIPLINE AND LAW AND ORDER. (a) In this
10 section, "disciplinary proceeding" means:

17 (b) A professional employee of a school district may not be
18 subject to disciplinary proceedings for:
19 (1) the reporting of a violation of Chapter 37 to

21 a law enforcement agency; or
22 (2) an action taken in good faith to remove a student
23 from class under Section 37.002

24 (c) The immunity provided by Subsection (b) is in addition

1 to any other immunity provided by law. This section may not be
2 construed to interfere with any other immunity provided by law.

3 SECTION 2. This Act applies to a disciplinary proceeding
4 for conduct that occurs before, on, or after the effective date of
5 this Act, except that a disciplinary proceeding finally resolved
6 before the effective date of this Act is unaffected by this Act.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
11 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
